Scoring system

1st place = 1 pt, 2nd place = 2 pts, 3rd = 3 pts, 4th = 4 pts, 5th = 5 pts, 6 = 6 pts

Combination of low points wins. For example 1st, 2nd and 5th = 8 points

In event of capsized, 10 point penalty

Race course

International Team Racing with 6 marks, 5 legs (beat, reach, run, reach, beat)

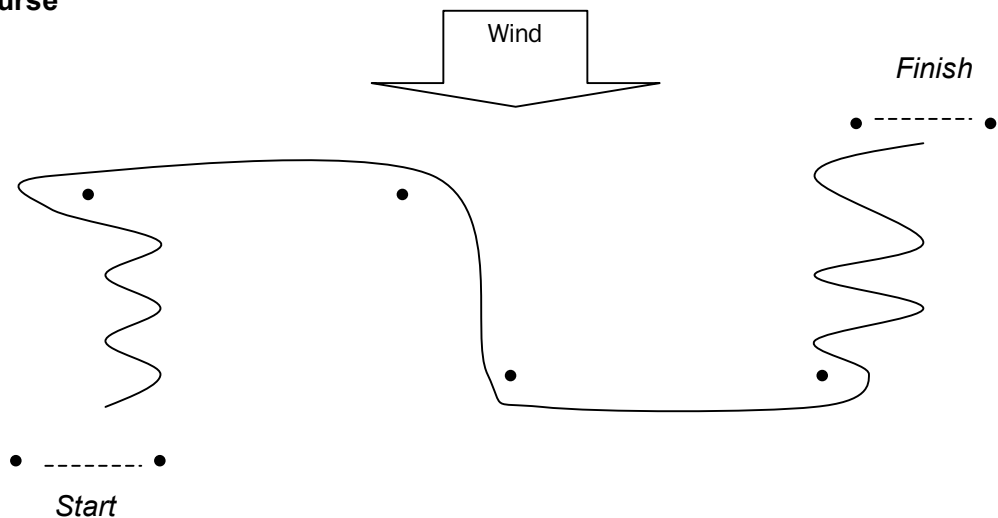
Just 2 teams (6 boats) race at one time.

Start and race sequence

3-minute start sequence, start one race, and then 3 minutes start next race, again, again, again. It will be set up as a round-robin so each team will race several times.

After the round robins results are tallied, the fleet will be split into a Gold and Silver fleet for finals.

Rules

If competitor accepts infringement, then 360 degree penalty

If Jury Boat is hailed -- red flag = 720 degree penalty, green flag = no penalty

Boat safety

All boats will be safety checked for:

- Life vest
- Bailers
- Paddle
- 3 buoyancy bags
- Bow line for towing
